

# Safety instructions for installing and using the plastic case

## 1. Preparation before installation:

- Make sure the smartphone is switched off to avoid accidental operations on the screen.
- Thoroughly clean the surface of the smartphone, especially the back cover and sides, with a soft microfibre cloth.
- Check the case for any damage or dirt that could scratch the smartphone.

## 2. Case installation:

- **Step 1:** Insert the phone into the case from one side - usually you should slide in the top of the smartphone or the side with the side buttons first.
- **Step 2:** Gently press the remaining edges of the phone to seat it properly in the case. Make sure all corners fit well.
- **Step 3:** Check that the case does not cover the ports, speakers, camera or buttons. All cut-outs and openings should be precisely aligned.

## 3. Using the case:

- Clean the case regularly to remove dust and small particles of dirt that may cause scratches on the smartphone. Use a soft, damp cloth.
- Avoid exposing the case to prolonged contact with high temperatures (e.g. direct sunlight), as this may cause the material to warp.
- Avoid dropping the phone from a great height - the plastic case protects against light shocks and scratches, but may not withstand heavy impacts.
- While charging, make sure the case does not block the charging cable or wireless charging area (if supported).
- If the case becomes loose or damaged (cracks, deformations), replace it with a new one to ensure full protection of the phone.

## 4. Maintenance and cleaning:

- **Cleaning the case:**
  - Remove the case from the phone.
  - Wash the case with warm water and mild soap or a cleaner for plastics.
  - Dry the case thoroughly with a soft cloth before putting it back on the phone.
- **Cleaning frequency:** Once every 1-2 weeks to prevent dirt and bacteria from building up.

## 5. Removing the case:

- **Step 1:** Gently bend back one of the corner parts of the case, starting from the bottom of the smartphone.
- **Step 2:** Gradually remove the case from the remaining edges of the phone.
- **Step 3:** Avoid forcing the phone out to prevent damage to the device or the case itself.

## 6. Safety precautions:

- Do not use a damaged case, as it may not provide adequate protection for the phone.
- Make sure the case does not cover the phone's ventilation openings to avoid overheating the device.
- Avoid contact of the case with chemicals (e.g. solvents, oils) that may damage the plastic.
- If you use the smartphone intensively, it is worth combining the case with a protective film or tempered glass for better screen protection.
- Use original or certified cases that are properly matched to your phone model.

**Proper installation and use of the case will ensure effective protection of the phone against scratches, dirt and minor mechanical damage.**
